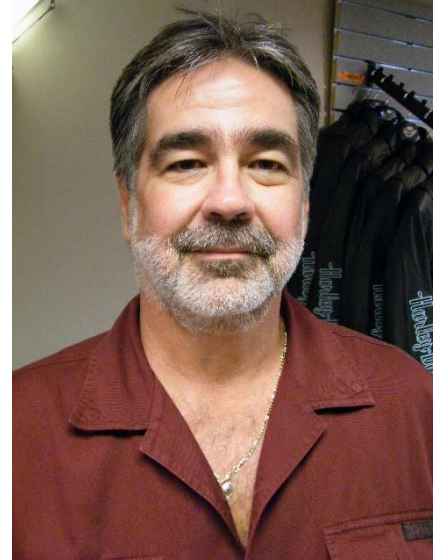

Safety Article:

IMPAIRMENT - Self Imposed

There are more ways to get hurt out on the roadway than there is room to write about it, so why are “self imposed” impairments such a common problem among the biking community? I have heard many arguments and rationalizations, but it still does not make sense to me. If I wanted to get a rush, feel free, exercise my rights and freedoms, I suppose I could put a patch over my right eye, my gloves on the wrong hands, strap my helmet to my knee, ride side saddle sitting in the passenger seat, and text while racing my motorcycle across Broward Blvd. to the beach. Most people would think I was nuts. To be riding visually impaired, lacking hand and foot control and coordination, off-balance without proper protection, not focused on driving and behaving irresponsibly, is basically riding while exercising poor judgment. That would be nuts!!

Self imposed impairment comes in many flavors, such as not wearing your required prescription glasses, riding with a dirty windshield you cannot see through, or how about riding a poorly maintained bike? All of these behaviors can impede your ability to ride safely and minimize your risk. There are many things that can handicap your ability to ride safe, but when we think of impairments we usually think of alcohol. Drinking is the main form of “self imposed” impairment with a high percentage of associated fatalities, injuries, crashes and tickets,

But there are other behaviors that can affect your ability to exercise good judgment, maintain good vision capabilities, and maintain proper balance and coordination.

Medications - Many over-the-counter products, prescriptions and illegal drugs can affect/reduce your vision, coordination and judgment.

Stimulus products – caffeine, nicotine, diet products, energy drinks, herbal products.

Fatigue - not rested and alert before starting your trip, not conditioned for long rides, too many hours in the saddle, fighting environmental conditions

Emotions - taking the bike out “to blow off steam”.

Riding when you are emotionally upset can impair your judgment and distract you.

Physical Needs - riding while dehydrated, cold, hungry, or overly anxious to get there.

Riding to the limit - Ever heard of a runner’s high? Riding your motorcycle while juiced up on adrenaline from riding over your limit, taking chances, and excessive speed can give you a false sense of control. That rush can lead you to take more and more chances.

All of these behaviors or choices are “self imposed”. These impairments were not forced on you by anyone. You made the choice to ride impaired. You can make the choice not to handicap or impede your performance. Please don’t ride impaired!

IMPORTANT CHAPTER RIDE POLICIES



In the event that inclement weather interferes with our scheduled rides, please be advised of our long-standing policy regarding cancellation of a ride. While it is always a member's option to go on a chapter ride whenever we have inclement weather, a decision will be made by the Lead Road Captain whether the SANCTIONED ride will take place. Riding in inclement weather is a safety issue we should always consider. The formal cancellation of a ride will occur at the time and place the ride begins. The Lead Road Captain running the ride will be present at the designated time and place the ride begins to advise those present of the decision.

While the HOG Ft. Lauderdale Chapter #3343 always promotes riding, we have a responsibility to our members, H.O.G. National, our sponsoring Dealer and Harley-Davidson. All participants in our rides must be a current member of H.O.G. National and our local Chapter. All members are issued a local membership card that must be shown at the time of the ride. If the card is not available, a waiver must be signed prior to the ride. Guests are allowed on up to 3 rides and must sign a waiver prior to each ride. At the 3rd ride, Guests will be asked to become a member. Participants without membership cards or signed waivers will not be allowed to participate in any Chapter events. Guests are not allowed to participate in the fourth event. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

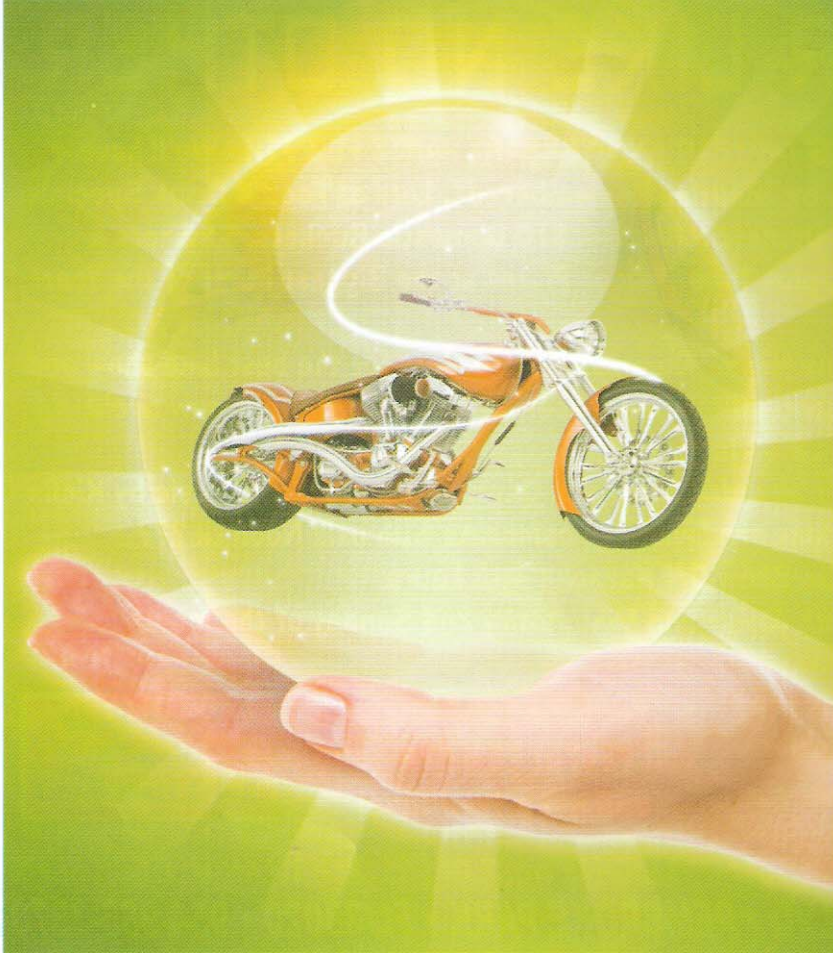
