Speaking Directly

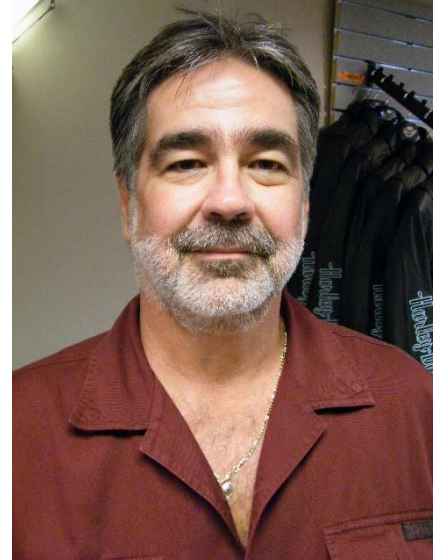

Safety Article: SO YOU WANT TO BE SEEN

Not like the center of attention but out on the road where it matters. Have you ever considered a headlight or brake light modulator? How about an air horn?

Headlight modulators are being used all across the country by police, fire, all 5 branches of the armed services, and of course regular bikers like you and me. Modulators flicker rather than flash. The light pulsates between 200-280 beats per minute and to avoid target fixation they flicker from full brightness to half brightness. This pulsating light draws peoples attention. Mark Turkel uses a Biker Buddy which he says is advertised as the #1 headlight modulator on the market. Mark has been using the BB for about 2 years now, and although it doesn't magically protect him from harm, it absolutely does get people's attention on the road. "Cars have not turned left or pulled out in front of me since I started using it, and I really do notice a difference. People see me. To me, it's the best safety device I have on the bike." say Mark. Those riders that have the modulator on their bike swear by them. Some people complain about modulating headlights flashing in their rear view mirror at stops and during group rides but it can be turned off by going to low-beams or use of an on/off switch. All modulators have a light sensor that turns off the flickering at night. Most installation takes less than 15 minutes, as it plugs in between the bulb and the stock connector with the unit stuffed inside the headlight out of sight.

Modulating brake lights also improve visibility and catch people's attention. As you apply the brakes, the module causes the brake lights to flicker several times before going solid red. Both headlight and brake light modulators are available in the after market and readily available. More and more people are adding these devices to their motorcycles. For safety you might consider it as well. And yes, they are legal in all states if properly manufactured to meet federal standards.

Horns also get peoples attention with air horns being the loudest. A stock HD horn registers at about 87 decibels (dB), a semi at around 105 dB and a train at around 110 dB. Research indicates that loud horns are more effective than loud pipes. Many horns can be compromised by water. So, be careful not to flood the horn area when washing your bike. Heavy rains have also been known to

silence a motorcycle horn. Be sure part of your pre-ride inspection includes testing the horn. A siren gets peoples attention but a siren running constantly is just noise. The same is true with your horn use it when needed but don't over use.

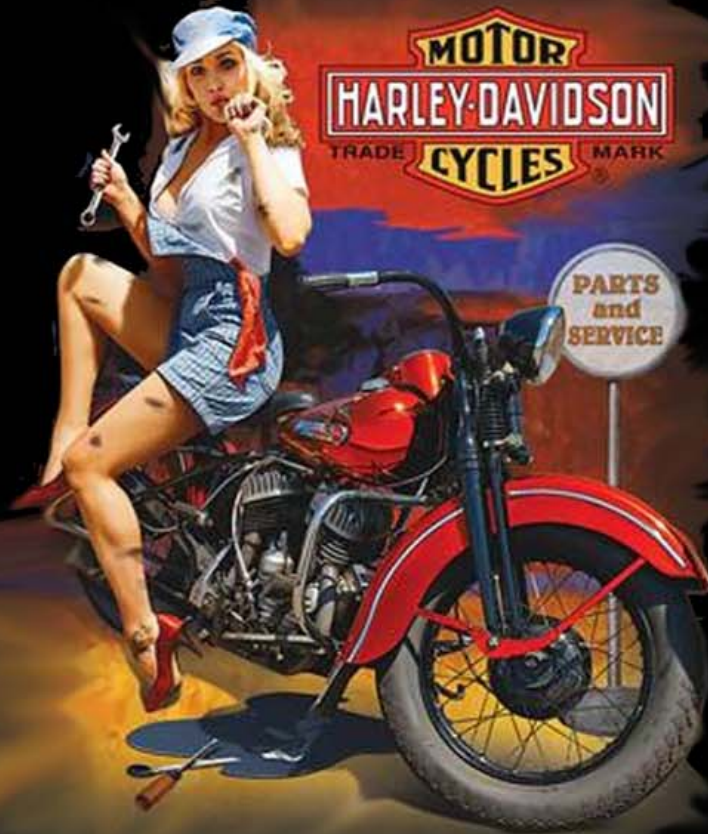

IMPORTANT CHAPTER RIDE POLICIES



In the event that inclement weather interferes with our scheduled rides, please be advised of our long-standing policy regarding cancellation of a ride. While it is always a member's option to go on a chapter ride whenever we have inclement weather, a decision will be made by the Lead Road Captain whether the SANCTIONED ride will take place. Riding in inclement weather is a safety issue we should always consider. The formal cancellation of a ride will occur at the time and place the ride begins. The Lead Road Captain running the ride will be present at the designated time and place the ride begins to advise those present of the decision.

While the HOG Ft. Lauderdale Chapter #3343 always promotes riding, we have a responsibility to our members, H.O.G. National, our sponsoring Dealer and Harley-Davidson. All participants in our rides must be a current member of H.O.G. National and our local Chapter. All members are issued a local membership card that must be shown at the time of the ride. If the card is not available, a waiver must be signed prior to the ride. Guests are allowed on up to 3 rides and must sign a waiver prior to each ride. At the 3rd ride, Guests will be asked to become a member. Participants without membership cards or signed waivers will not be allowed to participate in any Chapter events. Guests are not allowed to participate in the fourth event. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

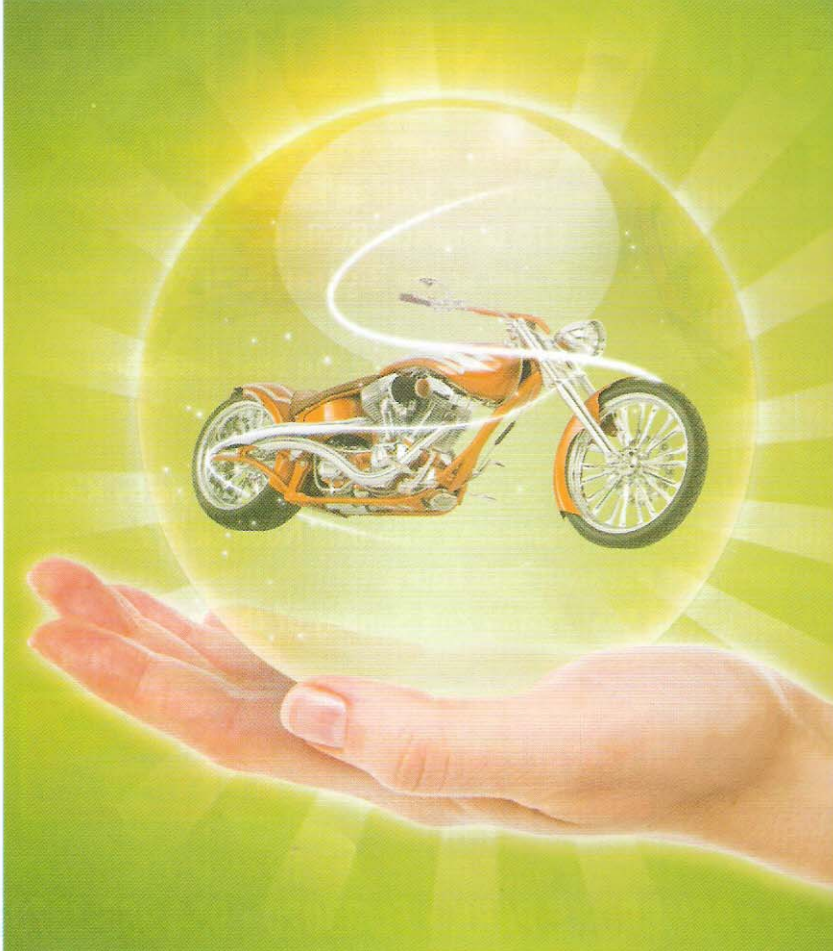
